What is the Teacher Study Program?

The Teacher Study Program is designed to give Florida K-12 teachers an opportunity to plan and/or prepare for a field trip to The Florida Aquarium.

Who is eligible?

All K-12 Florida teachers that are currently teaching in a Florida public, private or charter school. Administrators, guidance counselors, aides, assistants, college/university faculty, support personnel and out-of-state teachers are NOT eligible.

What is required for a teacher to receive a Teacher Study Card?

1. Complete the Teacher Study Program application online
2. Provide Department of Education number (DOE)
3. If you work for a private school and do not have a DOE #, you must submit a letter from your principal.

Teachers must complete the Teacher Study Program application online and submit the application prior to arrival at The Florida Aquarium, walk ups will pay full admission. The application with DOE number can be directly emailed to education@flaquarium.org. Reservations will process the application within 72 hours and a Teacher Study Card will be mailed to the address provided within two weeks. Please contact Reservations at 813-273-4015 if you have any questions or do not receive your card within two weeks.

What does the Teacher Study Ticket Program entitle the Teacher to?

The Teacher Study Program entitles the teacher to complimentary admission through August 31st, 2017

What if the teacher wants to bring their child/friends/family with them to the aquarium?

The teacher's admission will be complimentary with a photo ID. All others in the party pay full admission price. If the child/friend/family member has a membership, the membership holder must also be present.

Is the Teacher Study Program an annual membership pass?

The Teacher Study Program is NOT a membership or annual pass to The Florida Aquarium. The Teacher Study Program provides complimentary admission for the designated teacher. The Teacher Study Program card is active after the application and proof of DOE number is submitted. The program expires on August 31st, 2017 and the teacher will need to reapply.

What if a teacher would like to purchase an annual membership?

Florida Teachers can upgrade to a party of 2 or higher by trading in your Teacher Study Program card for a Membership card. The teacher must be a primary person listed on the membership. The second primary person listed must be 16 years of age or older. The discounted rates for teachers are listed below. If you want to by-pass the Teacher Study Program card and purchase a discounted membership you can contact Membership directly with your DOE number and the name of your school. Memberships include free parking, discounts in the Café and Gift Store and much more! Just bring your Membership card and a photo ID on your next visit.

No refunds will be given to existing memberships! Memberships are valid for one year.

Does the teacher get free admission the day of their field trip?

No, teachers and members are counted as chaperones on field trip days. They may choose to count themselves as one of the free chaperones based on the 1 chaperone free per 10 kids, additional chaperones will pay the student rate.

Walk-up Teachers

The Teacher Study Program application must be completed online 72 hours prior to your first visit. Walk ups will pay full admission price.
